Milwaukee: General Mitchell International Airport (MKE), a moderately-sized airport approx 35 minutes from the show site via I-94. MKE is the hub for Midwest and is also serviced by Delta, Continental, Northwest, United, US Airways, and American.

If you don't want to rent a car, a private local shuttle service is available by reservation to take you between the show site and the Milwaukee airport. It's reasonably priced, easy to reserve, and available almost 24 hours a day. Reservations required. Chicago: O'Hare International Airport

(ORD) is a 90 minute drive from the show site on Interstates 90 and 94. Shuttle service is not available from Chicago to our hotel, you must rent a car and drive.

Sadly, it's becoming increasingly difficult to fly our Chows to events regardless of the time of year. Some airlines have cut back on flights, downsized their jets, or stopped carrying dogs at all. If Milwaukee can't provide the air service you need for your Chow, Chicago may offer a wider choice of direct flight options.

Based on Pat's acclaimed video, "Puppy Puzzle: The Hastings Approach to Evaluating the Structural Quality of Puppies," this presentation will benefit everyone working with dogs and every puppy out of a conscientious breeding program. Together, the Hastings won over 250 Best In Shows with dogs from all groups and bred over 28 different breeds from across all groups. In 2001, they received the Doberman Pinscher Club of America's Lifetime Achievement Award. Pat is currently an AKC judge of the Herding, Non-Sporting and Working Groups; Junior Showmanship; and Best in Show.
