The club is actively monitoring the local situation with regard to the COVID-19. We are gathering information from multiple sources (Federal, State & Local) and the host hotel. At this time, we are continuing as planned to host our National Specialty shows from April 27 - 30, 2020.

The CCCI Show Committee is working to ensure a safe environment by following CDC & Local Health Department guidelines & protocols. If the CCCI Officers and Board of Directors determines that hosting the show could not be done in a safe manner, you will be notified as quickly as possible. We are aware that other parent clubs have canceled their National Specialties and others are reviewing their options.

Last Sunday, I asked our CCCI Recording Secretary, Marisol Allen, to send out a notice for a special teleconference Board Meeting for March 15th at 8 PM (EST) to discuss the National Specialty and the impacts of the Corona virus. The purpose of the meeting is to put in place a contingency plan for the National Specialty. The situation is changing by the day and no one knows what the situation will be in late April, but we need to take all necessary precautions and understand all financial, health, federal, state and local implications to the Club.

We will be in constant contact with the host hotel and the superintendent to ensure we are doing everything possible to make the specialty as safe as possible should it go forward.
